

Notify Your Child's School

Returning to school this year looks different than previous years. New procedures are in place to help reduce the spread of illness. This checklist is intended to help parents and guardians know what to report and when to report to your child's school.



If your child has received a positive test result for COVID, contact your child's school



If your child has been in close contact with someone who has COVID, contact your child's school. This includes living in the same household, being within 6 feet of the person for 15 minutes or longer, or being in direct contact (e.g., sharing utensils, coughing, sneezing, kissing, etc.).



If your child has been tested and is waiting on results, contact your child's school



If a member of your child's immediate household is in isolation or quarantine and is sick or has received a positive test result, contact your child's school

Symptoms of COVID

Cough, fatigue, muscle pain or soreness, nasal congestion or runny nose, temperature greater than 100 or chills, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, headache, loss of appetite, new loss of taste or smell
